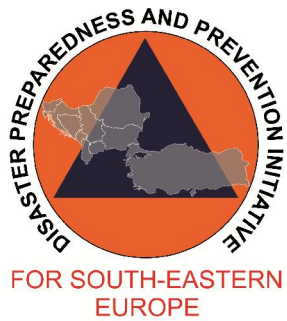

Main DRR national activities / achievements in 2016

Priority 1: *Understanding disaster risk*

Project "National risk assessment RO-RISK" – march 2016 to september 2017 (official website: <https://gis.ro-risk.ro/site/>)

- *National risk assessment methodology developed;*
- *10 risks at national level assessed (floods, earthquake, landslides, forest fires, SEVESO, transport accidents involving hazardous materials, zoonosys, epidemics, nuclear accidents, drought);*
- *developing a risk portal (GIS portal and database) as an instrument for risk assessment (<https://www.ro-risk.ro/SitePages/Pornire.aspx> - only in Romanian language);*
- operationalizing the National Platform and National Working Group for Risk Assessment (GLERN) – **the nominalization process was reopened**

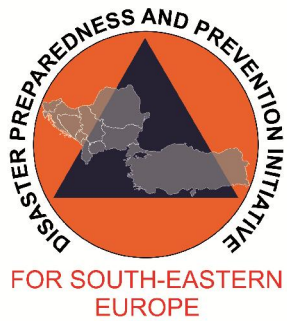
Main DRR national activities / achievements in 2016

Main DRR national activities / achievements in 2016

Priority 4: Enhancing disaster preparedness for effective response and to “Build Back Better” in recovery, rehabilitation and reconstruction

- 30.281.959,02 euro, floods response

2) EFFICIENT RESPONSE SAVES LIVES II

- 24.507.788 euro, floods, fires and landslides response

3) MULTIRISC – MODUL I

-35.250.179,41 euro, floods, earthquake, landslides, industrial accidents and public services failure response

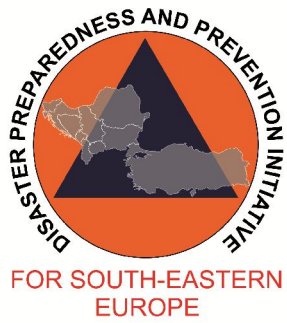
4) NATIONAL RISK ASSESSMENT (RO-RISK)

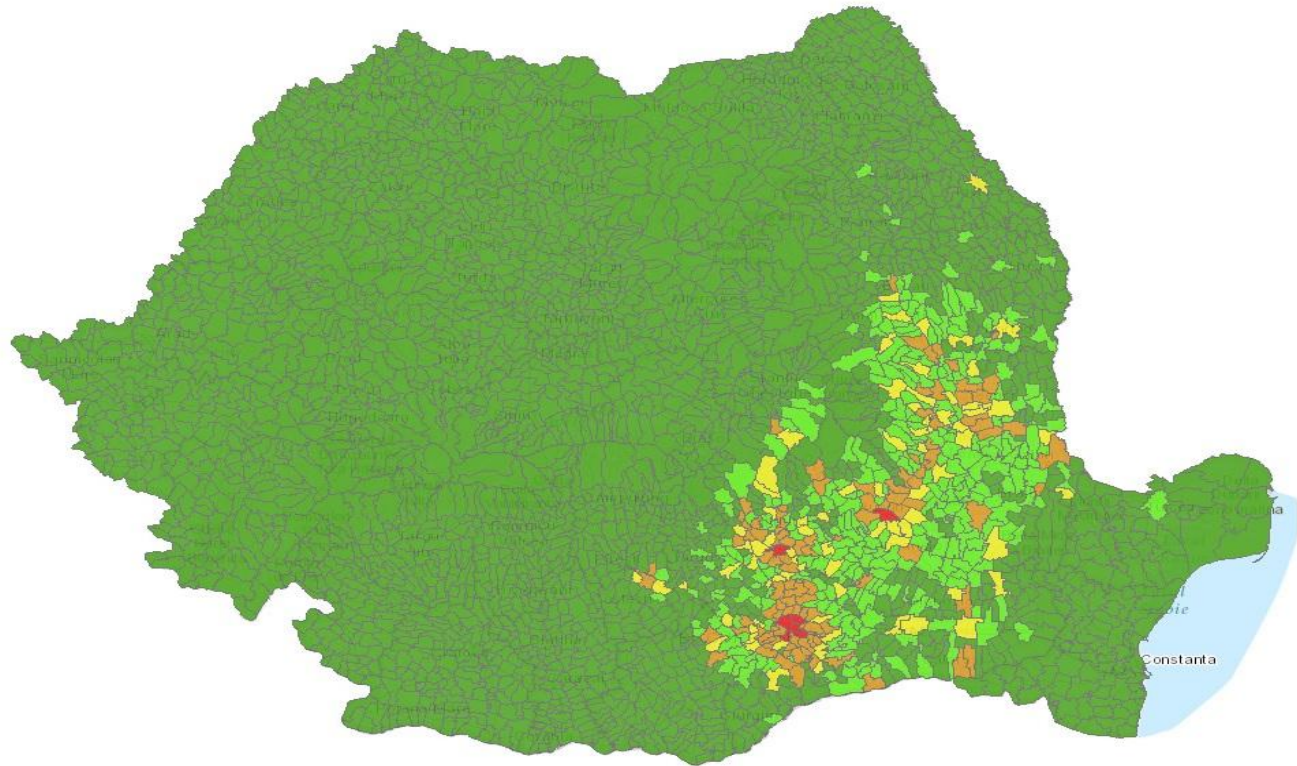


Main DRR national activities to be fulfilled in 2017

- update and strengthening dissemination location-based disaster risk information, including risk maps.

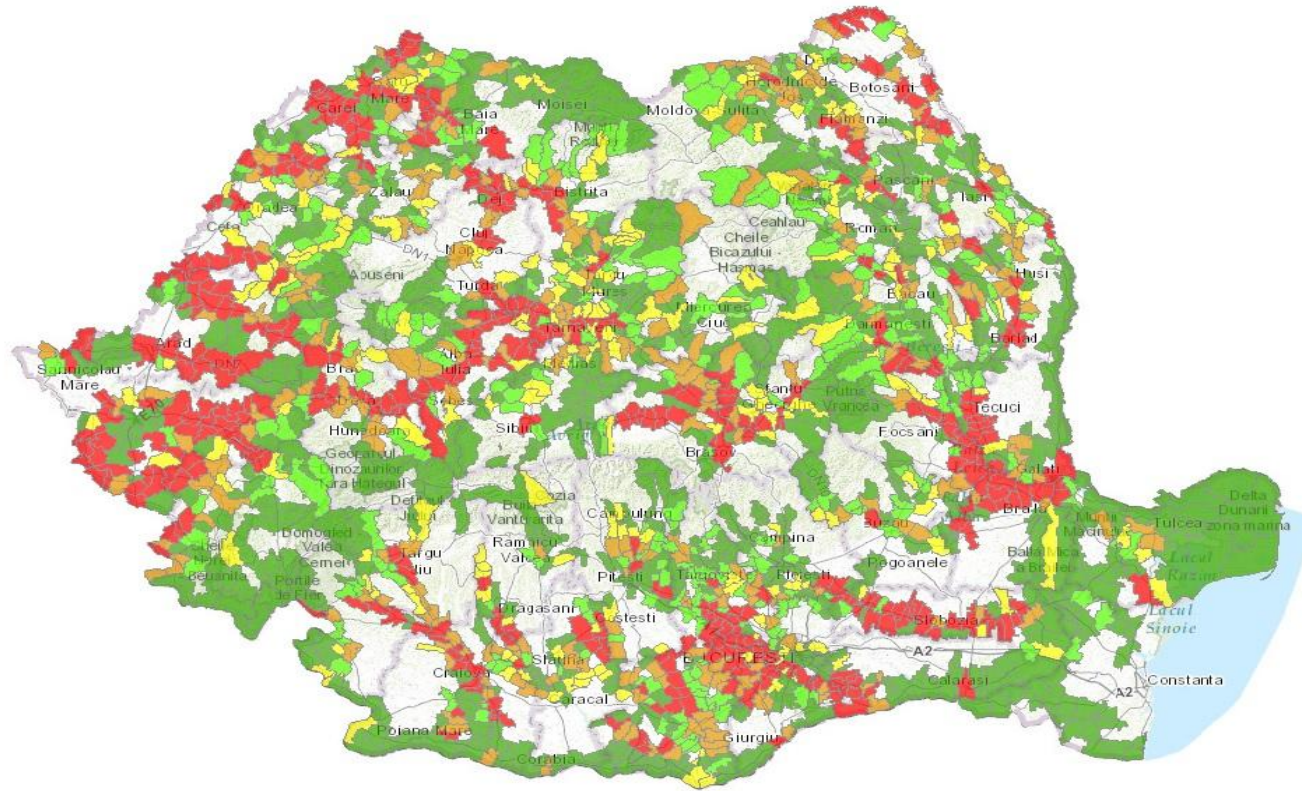


Earthquake-national qualitative risk
